

## Algebra II Pre-AP Information about the Spring Semester Exam

- The spring semester exam consists of 50 equally-weighted multiple-choice questions.
- The 50 questions are divided into 2 parts of 25 questions each. This will work very much like the 2-part tests that we have had previously this year:
  - You may use a calculator on the first part only.
  - When you finish the Calculator portion of the test, you will turn in your calculator and pick up the second half of the test, but you will also KEEP the first portion of the test.
  - You may continue to work on the calculator portion after turning in your calculator, but you may NOT get your calculator back once you have turned it in.
- Many problems on the first half of the test do NOT require a calculator.
- The problems in each section are more or less in order from the beginning of the semester to the end.
- The problems are more or less evenly distributed among the lessons, with each lesson being represented by 1 - 2 questions.
- Your grade may or may not be a straight percent correct out of 50. However, if "adjustments" to the grades are necessary, these will be given ONLY to those students who do all of the following:
  - Turn in COMPLETED review assignments
  - Have EVERY review problem worked, checked, and, if necessary corrected AND
  - SHOW LEGIBLE WORK for all review problems
